The Great Ocean Road Landslides 2016

The Great Ocean Road traders are open for Business!

LANDSLIDES INFORMATION

Over the last week, over 120 landslides impacted various locations along The Great Ocean Road between Fairhaven and Skenes Creek.

VicRoads staff and contractors, working daylight to dusk, seven days a week across these 120 sites have cleared in excess of six thousand cubic metres of rock and soil, roughly two Olympic sized swimming pools.

Significant road clearing works continue to be undertaken to keep the Great Ocean Road open for safe public use.

The Great Ocean Road Update

Note: Roads impacted by landslides and floodwater have enforceable road restrictions in place. For alternative routes see map overleaf.

- **The road remains closed between Separation Creek & Wye River due to major landslide risks**
- Road is open from Fairhaven to Separation Creek,
- Road is open from Apollo Bay to Wye River, and
- 24 hour Traffic Management Points have been set up at the corner of Stanway Drive & Great Ocean Road, and the corner of Durimbil Ave and Koonya Ave. Access through these TMP is for residents only.

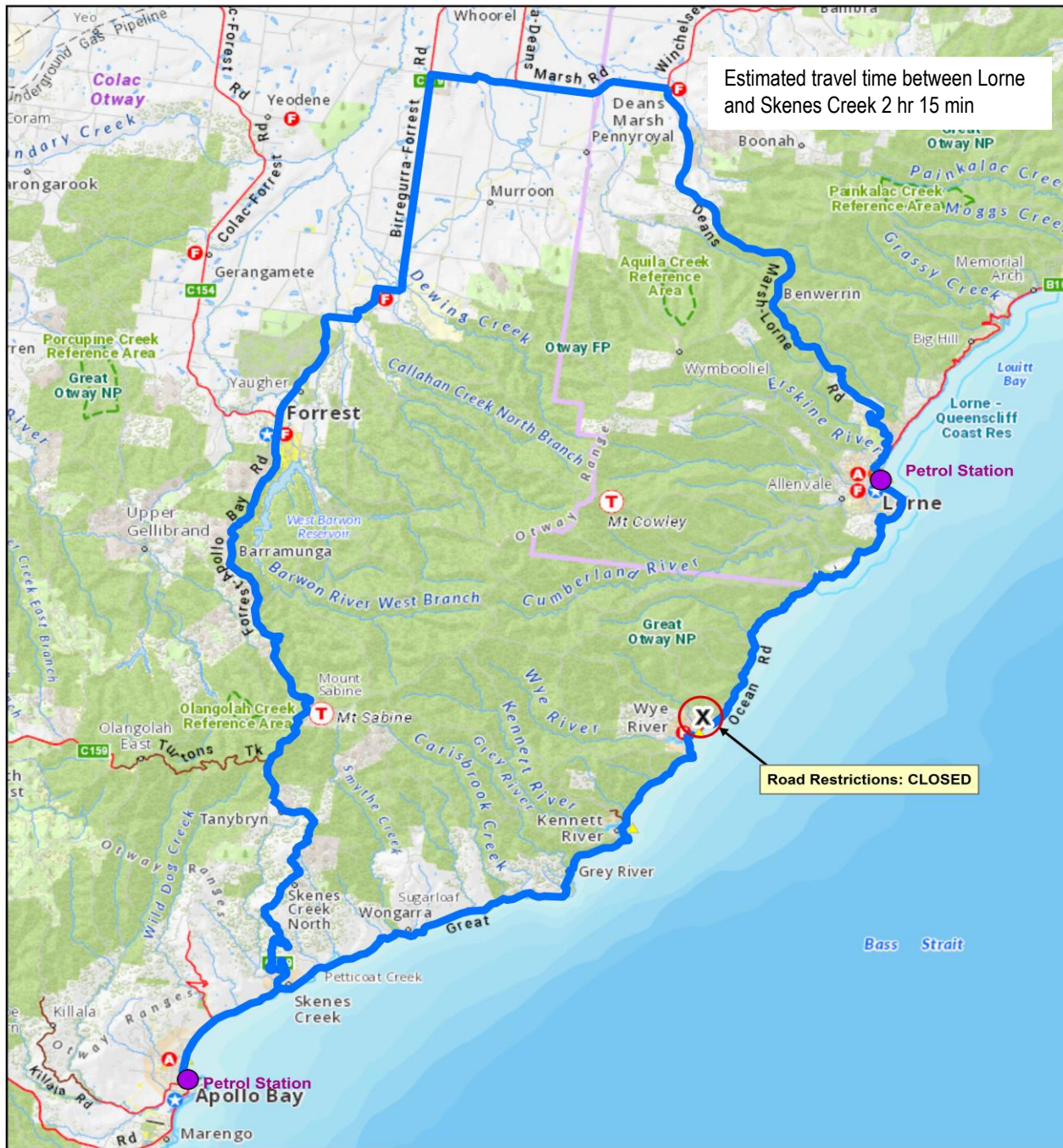
